Delivery Scams?.....They have not gone away!

Look out for fraudsters impersonating the Post Office in text messages. Bit of a clue, Royal mail deliver parcels and not the post office, so if you get text message like below, asking you to click on a link and give personal information or to pay a fee, it is a scam.
